


## Global Entrepreneurship Monitor 2015

An estimated 55% of the world's social entrepreneurs were men and 45% women. The gender gap in social entrepreneurial activity was significantly smaller than the estimated 2:1 gender gap in commercial entrepreneurial activity found in some economies.







