Start-up Programmes



Have a business idea or interest in entrepreneurship but not sure how to take those first steps?

Apollo is a six week part-time programme (run once a term) for budding entrepreneurs to experiment with their ideas - each week we'll cover a key theme involved in starting up, such as lean startup or marketing on a budget. With a mix of taught masterclasses, lessons from real-life guest entrepreneurs & practical group learning, Apollo will give you what you need to take your idea into orbit.

BSEEN is a start-up support programme for current students & recent graduates (up to 5 yrs) who are ready to commit to their business.

Across a 12 month period, successful applicants can access a wide range of support: a co-working space shared with like-minded entrepreneurs, a £500 business grant to get things off the ground, a 5 day intensive bootcamp, mentoring, networking opportunities & more. The next application period for the programme will be in Feb 2019.


